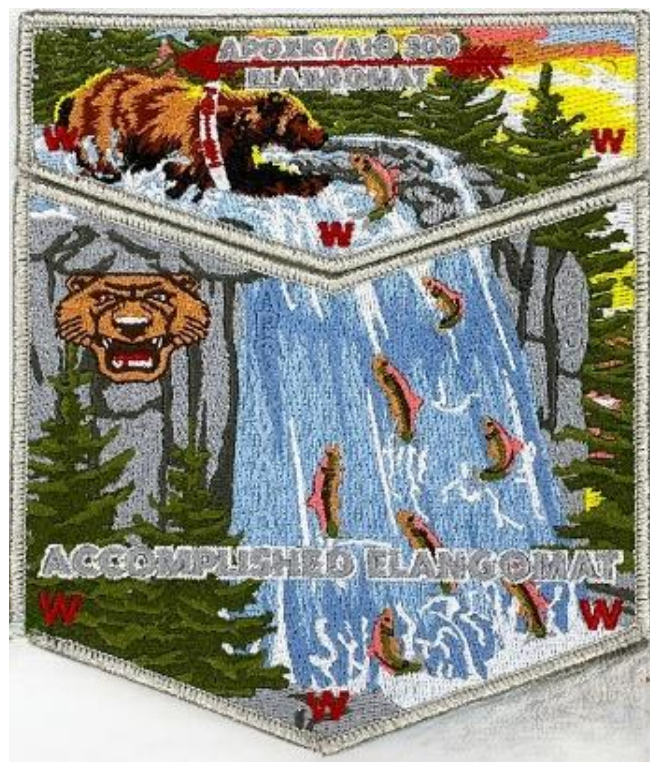
ORDER OF THE ARROW

The Roll of the Elangomat

The central role of the elangomat is to provide a living example of the ideals of the OA, and, through leadership in cheerful service, assist the candidates in meeting the challenges of the Ordeal.

“Elangomat,” the Lenape word for “friend,” is the term given to an Arrowman who supervises a crew of candidates, commonly referred to as a “crew.” They lead by their example — as the elangomat successfully completes each challenge of the Ordeal, they show the candidates that they can as well.

Individuals serving as Elanomats are eligible for a two-part special recognition patch set. The top half is awarded to those serving their first year as an elangomat. The bottom half is awarded to individuals that serve another year and complete additional tasks.



Top Half

Serve as an Elangomat at an Apoxky-Aio Lodge Ordeal

BOTTOM HALF

1. Contact Each Member or your Crew at least once before Fall Fellowship and once between the Fall Fellowship and the next Ordeal Cycle
2. Ensure at least one member of your crew attends Fall Fellowship, Spring Training and a following ordeal
3. Ensure at least 50% of your Crew is converted to Brotherhood by the end of the next ordeal cycle.
4. Attend one of the following: A Scouting America Council summer camp, Scouting America High Adventure Base, National or World Jamboree, NOAC or NYLT'
Or: serve on Camp, NYLT or Wood Badge staff
5. Convert to Brotherhood if you haven't already.
6. Be current dues paying member of the Lodge.

The Elangomat recognition program is available to both youth and adult Elangomats. Elangomats must keep their own progress record sheet, which must be signed by a lodge officer.
