

FOUNDER'S AWARD



Introduced at the 1981 National Order of the Arrow Conference, the Founder's Award was created to honor and recognize those Arrowmen who have given outstanding service to their lodge. The award is reserved for an Arrowman who demonstrates that he or she personifies the spirit of selfless service, as advocated by founder E. Urner Goodman and cofounder Carroll A. Edson. Lodges are permitted to award up to four awards annually, based on their total annual membership. Apoxy Aio Lodge is allowed up to two.

Recipients of this award receive the medallion illustrated above a framed certificate and a distinctive red drop arrow for uniform wear.
