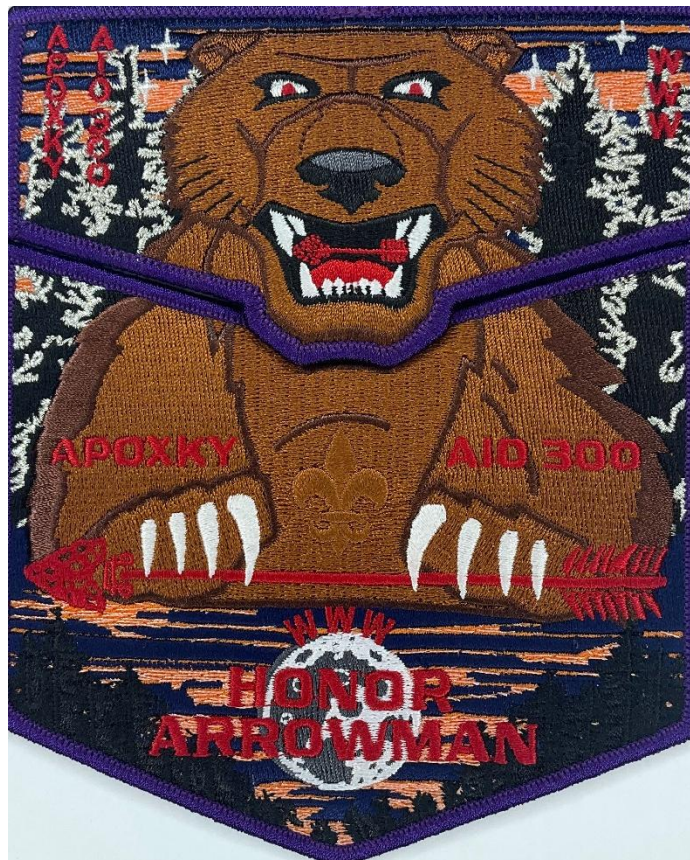
Honor Arrowman

The Honor Arrowman program encourages members to become involved in the Lodge and their local chapters promoting the ideals of the Order of the Arrow and Scouting America. Completing some defined requirements allows members the opportunity to purchase the Honor Arrowman patch set as each section is earned and is authorized for uniform wear.

The top half is earned first. The bottom half may be earned upon the completion of the requirements a second time.

Completed requirements must be reviewed and approved by a Lodge officer or Chapter Adviser prior to purchase.

Patches may be purchased through the Lodge trading post.



YOUTH

Honor Arrowman Requirements

Cheerful Service to Your Unit

A. Do **ALL** the following:

1. Give a presentation in your unit concerning what the Order of the Arrow is (may be done as a group of Arrowmen).
2. Conduct a camp skills or camp program at your own or another regular unit meeting at least twice during the year (may be done as a group of Arrowmen).
3. Arrange an election for your unit.

B. Do **ONE** of the following:

1. Participate in a Montana Council Camporee, High Adventure Base, or attend National Jamboree
2. Encourage and sign up another Scout for summer camp.
3. Recruit a new youth or adult into scouting.
4. Participate in a national training program like NYLT, NAYLE, Powderhorn, or NLS

Cheerful Service to Yourself

Do **TWO** of the following:

1. Advance one Scouts BSA rank or earn one Venturing/Sea Scouts award
2. Serve on staff at a summer camp or NYLT.
3. If already an Eagle, help another scout with their Eagle project.
4. Earn the emblem of your religious faith.
5. Serve on your school's student council or serve on a school project committee.
6. Join another civic organization that performs community service.

Youth Requirements Continued

Cheerful Service to Your Lodge

A. Do **ALL** of the following:

1. Attain Brotherhood, or if Brotherhood encourage an Ordeal member to become Brotherhood.
2. Attend at least one Lodge function, Section event or be part of a Lodge contingent for NOAC.
3. Attend an Ordeal weekend (other than your own).
4. Pay dues in OA for the next year no later than December 1st of this year.
5. Be a part of a ceremonies team for one of the following ceremonies: Callout, Pre-Ordeal, Ordeal, or Brotherhood.

B. Do **ONE** of the following:

1. Serve on a Chapter or Lodge committee.
2. Serve as a Chapter or Lodge officer.
3. Serve as an Elangomat.
4. Serve as a member of a ceremonial team.
5. If Vigil, attend a Vigil weekend (other than your own).

ADULT

Honor Arrowman Requirements

Cheerful Service to Your Unit

Do **THREE** of the following:

1. Help a youth prepare and conduct a camp skill or camp promotion presentation.
2. Help a youth prepare and present a presentation concerning what the Order of the Arrow is.
3. Help a youth arrange an election for your unit.
4. Participate in a Montana Council Camporee, High Adventure Base, Wood Badge or attend a National Jamboree
5. Encourage and sign up a scout for summer camp.
6. Recruit a new youth or adult into scouting.
7. Participate in an ICL event.

Cheerful Service to Your District & Council

Do **TWO** of the following:

1. Perform a minimum of eight hours of service in a Council camp.
2. Participate in a district Camporee
3. Participate in at least one Chapter or Lodge service project.
4. Attend or give a training session during the course of the Lodge year.

Adult Requirements Continued

Cheerful Service to Your Lodge

A. Do **ALL** of the following:

1. Attain Brotherhood, or if Brotherhood encourage an Ordeal member to become Brotherhood.
2. Attend at least one Lodge function, Section event or be part of a Lodge contingent for NOAC.
3. Attend an Ordeal weekend (other than your own).
4. Pay dues in OA for the next year no later than December 1st of this year.
5. Be an advisor for a ceremonies team doing one of the following ceremonies: Callout, Pre-Ordeal, Ordeal, or Brotherhood.

B. Do **ONE** of the following:

1. Serve as an Advisor for a Chapter or Lodge committee.
2. Serve as an Advisor for a Chapter or Lodge officer.
3. Serve as an Elangomat.
4. If Vigil, attend a Vigil weekend (other than your own).
